**THE FOREST RESOURCES AND TIMBER UTILISATION ACT  
(Cap. 40)****THE FOREST RESOURCES AND TIMBER UTILISATION  
(PROTECTED SPECIES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2012**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 44 and item 7 of the First Schedule of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation Act, the following regulations are hereby made –

Citation                   **1.**       These Regulations may be cited as the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation (Protected Species) (Amendment) Regulations 2012.

Principal Regulations amended                   **2.**       The Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation (Protected Species) Regulations 2012 is amended as follows:-

(a)       by deleting Regulation 4 and replacing it with a new Regulation 4 as follows:

“4.       The following species shall only be exported in milled timber form pursuant to a milling licence issued by the Commissioner of Forest Resources:

Rosewood	-	Pterocarpus indicus
Ironwood	-	Instia bijuga
Kauri	-	Agathiss macrophyllia
Walnut	-	Dracontomelum vitiense
Canoe Tree	-	Gmelia moluccana
	-	Canarium spp.
Vasa	-	Vitex “

- (b) by adding a new Regulation 5 after Regulation 4 as follows:

“5. The following species shall only be exported in product form manufactured in Solomon Islands:

Rattan - Calamus spp.
