**FOREST RESOURCES AND TIMBER UTILISATION ACT
(Cap. 40)**

EXEMPTION ORDER

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4 (1) (c) of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation Act (Cap. 40), I make this Order –

1. That the land referred to in Schedule 1 of this Order (“the Land”) is exempted from the provisions of section 4 of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation Act [Cap. 40] and the provisions of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation (Protected Species) Regulations 2012 including any subsequent amendments therein.

2. The Land shall be used for agricultural purposes as certified by the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock Development.

3. All Felling of logs in the land shall comply with the terms and conditions of the special permit to be issued by the Commissioner of Forest.

4. Logs felled under clause 3 of this Order shall be exported and / or sold pursuant to the laws of Solomon Islands.

5. Records of logs felled, exported and / or sold shall be furnished to the Commissioner of Forest within fourteen (14) days of the export and or sale of such logs.

6. A person who contravenes any of the clauses in this Order is deemed to have committed an offence under section 4 of the Act, as if the exemption were not granted under this Order.
