ORDER 2013**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, **RICK HOUENIPWELA** Minister of Finance and Treasury make the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as Customs and Excise (Excise Duties) (Amendment) Order 2013, and commences on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
2. The First Schedule to the Customs and Excise Act, entitled EXCISE CLASSIFICATION AND TARIFF is hereby amended in the following respects:-
 - (a) by deleting the duty rate of "\$55.50" per kg which appears in respect of tariff item E.1 (a) and substituting therefor the duty rate "\$66.60" per kg
 - (b) by deleting the duty rate of "\$0.24" per stick which appears in respect of tariff item E.1 (b) and substituting therefor the duty rate "\$0.288" per stick
 - (c) by deleting the duty rate of "\$465.20" per kg which appears in respect of tariff item E.1 (c) and substituting therefor the duty rate "\$558.24" per kg.

**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (IMPORT DUTY) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER 2012**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, **IRICK HOUENIPWELA**, Minister of Finance and Treasury, do hereby make the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as Customs and Excise (Import Duty) (Amendment) Order 2013 and commences on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
2. The First Schedule to the Customs and Excise Act, entitled “IMPORT CLASSIFICATION AND TARIFF” is hereby amended in the following respects –
 - (a) by deleting the duty rate of “15%” per kg which appears in respect of tariff item “2401.0000” and substituting there for the duty rate “18%”;
 - (b) by deleting the duty rate of “\$525.30” per kg which appears in respect of tariff item “2402.1000” and substituting therefor the duty rate “\$630.36”;
 - (c) by deleting the duty rates of “\$1.30” per stick which appears in respect of tariff items “2402.2010”, “2402.2020”, “2402.9000” and substituting therefor the duty rate “\$1.56” per stick.
 - (d) by deleting the duty rate of “\$426.10” per kg which appears in respect of tariff items “2403.1010” and substituting there for the duty rate “\$511.32” per kg
 - (e) by deleting the duty rates of “\$693.40” per kg which appears in respect of tariff items “2403.1090”, “2403.9100”, “2403.9900” and substituting therefor the duty rate “\$832.08” per kg

**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (EXPORT DUTY RATES FOR ROUND LOGS)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2012**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, **Rick Nelson Houenipwela**, Minister for Finance and Treasury, do hereby make the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Export Duty Rates) (Amendment) No. 2 Order 2012 and shall commence on 1st April 2012 and expire on 30th June 2013.

2. This Order does not have the effect of allowing the export of species which are prohibited for export as round logs under the Forest Resources and Timber Utilization Act (Cap. 40) or any other Act.

3. The export duty payable on the export of round logs shall be calculated and determined in the manner provided in the Schedule herewith.

4. The First Schedule to the Customs Act under the heading 44.03 entitled "EXPORT CLASSIFICATION" is amended in the following respects –
