**THE FACILITATION OF INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE ACT 2003
(NO. 1 OF 2003)**

**THE FACILITATION OF INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE (WEAPONS
SURRENDER) (EXEMPTION) NOTICE 2013**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 20 and 21 of the Facilitation of International Assistance Act 2003, I **SIR ALLAN KEMAKEZA**, Knight of the British Empire Acting Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, do hereby make the following Notice:--

1. This Notice may be cited as the Facilitation of International Assistance (Weapons Surrender) (Exemption) Notice 2013.
2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Facilitation of International Assistance (Weapons Surrender) Notice 2003 made under the Facilitation of International Assistance Act 2003, the Member of the Fiji Military and Police Force participating for ceremonial purposes at the Solomon Islands Independence Celebration 2013 shall be permitted to carry guns and blank ammunitions for the period specified in paragraph 3.
3. This Notice shall be effective from the 3rd day of July, 2013 to 13th July 2013.
