1. To inquire into the causes surrounding the incident of vessels during the cause of their operations.
2. To make such findings in respect of the possible casualties involved as appropriate and also to consider officers' competencies during the cause of the Marine accident.
3. To make such recommendations resulting from the in-competencies, casualties and damages of the vessel as per the Board deemed reasonable and necessary in all of the circumstances as per the relevant regulations within the SI Shipping Act 1998 and its subsidiary legislations.
4. To make such Orders as the Board deemed reasonable and justifiable in all the Circumstances.

The Appointments were made according to Section 86 (1) & (2) of the SI Shipping Act 1998.

The period of appointment shall be valid for two (2) years, as of the date of this Appointment.
