LIQUOR ACT (Cap. 144)

THE BANNING OF THE SALE OF LIQUOR ORDER 2014

IN exercise of the powers conferred under section 82 (1) of the Liquor Act, the Minister hereby makes the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as the Banning of Sale of Liquor Order 2014 and shall come into force upon publication in the *Gazette*.
2. No liquor shall be sold from any licensed retail premises including night clubs or Bottle Shops within Solomon Islands effective from the 18th November to 25th November 2014.
3. Any person who contravenes subsection (2) commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding 2,000 penalty units or to imprisonment not exceeding 6 months.
4. The banning on sale by retail or supply of liquor does not apply to sale or supply of liquor by a hotel to its bona fide guest accommodated at the Hotel or at restaurant.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ACT
(Cap. 151)

APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY
19 NOVEMBER 2014

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 6 of the Act, I, Manasseh Maelanga, Minister for Home Affairs, appoint 19th November 2014 as holiday in all public offices in Solomon Islands for purposes of allowing all registered electors to vote at the 2014 General Election for members of the National Parliament.

For purposes of the Act, this special holiday shall not be taken into account in the computation of time under section 55 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act (Cap.86) in respect of the proclamation for the 2014 General Election made by the Governor-General pursuant to section 24 of the National Parliament Electoral Provisions Act (Cap.87).
