### LIQUOR ACT (Cap.144)

#### THE BANNING OF THE SALE OF LIQUOR ORDER (NO. 2) 2015

IN exercise of the powers conferred under section 82(1) of the Liquor Act, the Minister hereby makes the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as the Banning of Sale of Liquor Order 2015 and shall come into force upon publication in the *Gazette*.
2. No liquor shall be sold from any licensed retail premises including night clubs or Bottle Shops within Honiara City and Guadalcanal Province effective from Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> of October to Friday midnight 30<sup>th</sup> October 2015.
3. Any person who contravenes subsection (2) commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding 2,000 penalty units or to imprisonment not exceeding 6 months.
4. The banning on sale by retail or supply of liquor does not apply to sale or supply of liquor by a hotel to its bona fide guest accommodated at the Hotel or at restaurant.
