**PRESERVATION OF PUBLIC SECURITY (NO. 2)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2021**

I, Sir David Vunagi, the Governor-General, under section 3 of the *Preservation of Public Security Act* (Cap. 27), make the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Preservation of Public Security (No. 2) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2021*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the day they are published in the *Gazette*.

3 Amendment of Preservation of Public Security (No. 2) Regulations 2021

These Regulations amend the *Preservation of Public Security (No. 2) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice 334 of 2021) (“*Principal Regulations*”).

4 Regulation 3 amended

Regulation 3 of the *Principal Regulations* is amended:

- (a) by omitting the definition of “*foreign vessel*”; and
- (b) by omitting “other than a foreign vessel” from the definition of “*vessel*”;
and
- (c) by omitting the definition of “*wharf*”.

5 Regulation 7 repealed and substituted

Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is repealed and substituted with:

“7 Restriction of movement of vessels

(1) In this regulation:

“*foreign vessel*” means a vessel that is not registered in Solomon Islands or is not entitled to fly the Solomon Islands flag;

“*Port Authority*” means the Solomon Islands Port Authority established by section 6 of the Ports Act (Cap. 161);

“*vessel*” does not include a foreign vessel.

(2) This regulation does not apply to any of the following while performing his or her functions or duties or to a vessel operated by any of them:

- (a) an authorised officer;
- (b) personnel of a visiting contingent;
- (c) an officer of the Port Authority.

(3) On 2 December 2021, 3 December 2021 and 4 December 2021:

- (a) a vessel must not, between the hours of 7.00 pm and 6.00 am:
 - (i) enter or leave the Port of Honiara; or
 - (ii) come along side or berth at a wharf that is located within the Port of Honiara or anywhere else on the coast of the emergency zone; or
 - (iii) go on shore anywhere on the coast of the emergency zone; and
- (b) the operator of a vessel must not, between the hours of 7.00 pm and 6.00 am, permit or enable a person on board the vessel to disembark from the vessel and go ashore anywhere on the coast of the emergency zone.

(4) On and from 5 December 2021:

- (a) a vessel must not:
 - (i) enter or leave the Port of Honiara; or
 - (ii) come along side or berth at a wharf that is located within the Port of Honiara or anywhere else on the coast of the emergency zone; or
 - (iii) go on shore anywhere on the coast of the emergency zone; and
- (b) the operator of a vessel must not, permit or enable a person on board the vessel to disembark from the vessel and go ashore anywhere on the coast of the emergency zone.”.
