EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) REGULATIONS 2022**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19)(EXEMPTION FROM QUARANTINE PERIOD)(NO. 19) ORDER 2022**

I, Hon. Manasseh Maelanga, Deputy Prime Minister, under regulation 10 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2022* (Legal Notice 112 of 2022), make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19)(Exemption from Quarantine Period)(No. 19) Order 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Exemption from quarantine period

Each of the following persons is exempted from being quarantined for the quarantine period after they enter Solomon Islands on 8 June 2022:

- (a) Agus Wandī;
- (b) Adam Heal;
- (c) Stephanie Nadiza Magalage.

4 Condition of exemption

The exemption under paragraph 3 is subject to the condition that each person exempted must:

- (a) for the 6-day period immediately after entering Solomon Islands:
 - (i) subject to subparagraph (ii), be accommodated in a hotel in Honiara in a manner that complies with the Government's quarantine procedures; and
 - (ii) remain in the person's hotel room unless it is necessary for the person to leave the room to conduct official business; and
- (b) at all times while in Solomon Islands:
 - (i) practise hand hygiene; and
 - (ii) except when in the person's hotel room:

- (A) maintain physical isolation from any other person through social distancing; and
- (B) wear a face mask; and
- (c) on the second and fifth days after entering Solomon Islands, be tested at the Central Field Hospital in Honiara for the presence of COVID-19 by a PCR test, and test non-infectious for COVID-19 for each of the tests; and
- (d) be transported from the International Airport to the hotel in accordance with the Government's quarantine procedures.
