**CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE)
(SPEAKER) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2022**

I, Hon. Prime Minister, Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, under section 3 of the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act* (Cap. 84), the Prime Minister makes the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Speaker) (Amendment) Regulations 2022*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date they are published in the *Gazette*.

3 Principal Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Speaker) Regulations 1990* (“**Principal Regulations**”) (Legal Notice No. 144 of 1990).

4 Regulation 4 repealed and substituted

The Principal Regulation is amended by repealing regulation 4 and substituting the following:

“The speaker shall be paid his or her salary by fortnightly payments of \$11 000.00.”

5 Regulation 6 amended

Regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “\$15 000.00” and substituting “\$20 000.00”.

6 Regulation 7 amended

Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “\$5000.00” and substituting “\$6500.00”.

7 Regulation 9 amended

The Principal Regulations is amended by deleting regulation 9 and substituting the following:

“9(1) The Speaker shall be provided with a vehicle free of charge.

(2) If the speaker is not provided with a vehicle free of charge, he or she is entitled to:

(a) monthly vehicle allowance - \$6500.00; and

(b) monthly fuel allowance - \$4000.00.”

8 Regulation 14 amended

Regulation 14 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “\$12 000.00” and substituting “\$13 000.00”.

9 Regulation 15 amended

Regulation 15 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “\$12 000.00” and substituting “\$13 000.00”.

10 Regulation 17 repealed and substituted

The Principal Regulations is amended by repealing regulation 17 and substituting the following new regulation 17:

“17. The speaker shall be entitled to an annual medical expense of \$14 000.00.”

11 Regulation 23 amended

Regulation 23 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “\$15 000.00” and substituting “\$18 000.00”.

12 Regulation 24 amended

Regulation 24 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “\$2000.00” and substituting “\$3000.00”.

13 New regulation 25

The Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after regulation 24 the following new regulation:

“25. For each term of Parliament the speaker is entitled to a mobile handset worth \$4000.00 payable under the budget head of the National Parliament.”.
