POLICE ACT 2013

(No. 2 of 2013)

POLICE (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2025

I, Hon. Jimson Fiau Tanangada, Minister for Police, National Security and Correctional Services, under section 218 of the *Police Act 2013* (No. 2 of 2013), make these Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Police (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2025*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date they are published in the *Gazette*.

3 Amendment of Police Regulations 2013

These Regulations amend the *Police Regulations 2013* (Legal Notice No. 18 of 2014) (“*Principal Regulations*”).

4 Schedule 2 amended

The table under the heading “A. Special Allowance” in Schedule 2 of the *Principal Regulations* is amended as follows:

- (a) by deleting the two rows after the first heading row and all items relating to:
 - (i) “**Detective**”; and
 - (ii) “**Plain clothes**”;
- (b) by inserting the following after the row “**Special deployment allowances**”:

“National response allowance	All ranks	\$230.77 per fortnight for police officers who are formally qualified and posted to national operations units, including: (a) Police response team (b) Close personnel protection unit (c) Explosive ordnance disposal unit (d) Police maritime division (e) Fire and rescue service division
Detective allowance	All ranks	\$230.77 per fortnight for police allowance officers who are formally qualified to perform investigation duties
Prosecution allowance	All ranks	\$230.77 per fortnight for police officers who are formally qualified to carry out police prosecution functions
Forensic allowance	All ranks	\$230.70 per fortnight for police officers formally qualified to perform police forensic functions
Tradesman allowance	All ranks	\$230.77 per fortnight for police officers or specialist employees who are formally qualified and appointed to perform trade functions, including: (a) Plumber (b) Carpenter (c) Mechanic (d) Electrician (e) Information technology (f) Radio technician (g) Air-condition technician
Armed component allowance	All ranks	\$350 per fortnight for police officers who are formally qualified and authorised to carry a police firearm in the ordinary course of their duties
Plain cloth allowance	All ranks	\$200 per fortnight for police officers formally posted to perform police investigation functions
Bomb disposal allowance	All ranks	\$100 per day: (a) for police officers who are formally qualified in Explosive Ordnance Disposal operators; and (b) only when police officers are actively engaged in disposing of unexploded ordnance or bombs

Provincial posting allowance	Tier 1	\$250 per fortnight for police officers formally posted to a provincial station allowance or substation located within the boundaries of a provincial headquarter or suburban area
	Tier 2	\$350 per fortnight for police officers formally posted to a police post located in remote or rural areas outside of town boundaries”.

CORRECTIONAL SERVICES ACT

(No. 8 of 2007)

CORRECTIONAL SERVICES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025

I, Jimson Fiau Tanangada, Minister for Police, National Security and Correctional Services, under section 75 of the *Correctional Services Act 2007*, make these Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Correctional Services (Amendment) Regulations 2025*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date they are published in the *Gazette*.

3 Amendment of Correctional Services Regulations

These Regulations amend the *Correctional Services Regulations* (Legal Notice

No. 28 of 2008) (“*Principal Regulations*”).

4 Schedule 2 amended

The table under the heading “A. Special Allowance” in Schedule 2 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) in the heading row, insert a new column titled “**Type of allowance**” to the left of the current “**Rank of officer**” column;
- (b) insert the following after the last row of the table:

“Emergency response allowance	All ranks	\$230.77 per fortnight for officers who are formally qualified as members of the Emergency Response Group
Tradesman allowance	All ranks	\$230.77 per fortnight for officers and specialist employees who are formally appointed and qualified to perform the following trade functions: (a) Plumber (b) Carpenter (c) Mechanic (d) Electrician (e) Information technology (f) Radio technician (g) Air-condition technician (h) Locksmith
Provincial posting allowance	Tier 1	\$250 per fortnight for officers formally posted to provincial correctional centres within provincial headquarters or suburban boundaries
	Tier 2	\$350 per fortnight for officers formally posted to provincial correctional centres located in remote or rural areas outside of town boundaries”
