CONSUMPTION TAX ACT 2003
(Section 5(3)(a))

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 5(3)(a) of the Consumption Tax Act 2003, the Minister for Revenue and Customs, with the approval of Cabinet, makes the following Order:

- (1) That the importation of materials, subject to relevant design and building code regulations, for the construction of the Fatumu Wharf under the Fatumu Wharf Project shall be exempted from consumption tax.
- (2) However, in the case of the cancellation of the Fatumu Wharf Project and the materials imported for the project are sold, the exemption in paragraph (1) applicable at the time of importation, shall become payable immediately.
- (3) For the avoidance of doubt, consumption tax shall be payable if the materials or goods imported are used for any other purpose, other than the construction of the Fatumu Wharf under the Fatumu Wharf Project.

CUSTOMS ACT 2007

(Section 3(1)(b))

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3(1)(b) of the Customs Act 2007, the Minister for Revenue and Customs, with the approval of Cabinet, makes the following Order:

- (1) That the importation of materials, subject to relevant design and building code regulations, for the construction of the Fatumu Wharf under the Fatumu Wharf Project shall be exempted from customs duty.
- (2) However, in the case of the cancellation of the Fatumu Wharf Project and the materials imported for the project are sold, the exemption in paragraph (1) applicable at the time of importation, shall become payable immediately.
- (3) For the avoidance of doubt, customs duty shall be payable if the materials or goods imported are used for any other purpose, other than the construction of the Fatumu Wharf under the Fatumu Wharf Project.
