**CONSUMPTION TAX ACT [CAP 11.01]**

**(Section 5(3)(a))**

**ORDER**

**IN EXERCISE** of the powers conferred by section 5(3)(a) of the Consumption Tax Act [CAP 11.01], the Minister responsible for revenue and customs, with the approval of Cabinet makes the following Order –

- (1) That all imports of food items and personal consumer goods not for commercial purposes shall be exempted from consumption tax;
- (2) That this Order shall come into force on the date of gazettal; and
- (3) That this Order shall expire on 31 March 2021.
