## **SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET (NO.1) ACT 2025**

### **AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE APPROPRIATION OF MONIES OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR EXPENDITURES TO THE SERVICE OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2025**

#### **1 Short Title**

This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Budget (No.1) Act 2025.

#### **2 Authorisation of Expenditure**

The Minister by warrant under his hand, may issue from the consolidated fund for the financial year ending 30 June, 2025 a sum not exceeding seven million, eight hundred and seventy-four thousand, one hundred and eighty-eight dollars (\$7,874,188) in which this sum shall be appropriated in accordance with the Schedule for the purposes specified.

**PURPOSE OF EXPENDITURE****HEAD H: MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL WELFARE****1. Tuvalu Overseas Medical Referral Scheme (TOMRS)**

Total additional funding of \$6,182,517 is required to settle outstanding and ongoing medical bills for our referral patients under the Tuvalu Overseas Medical Referral Scheme.

**HEAD L: MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT, ENERGY, COMMUNICATION AND INNOVATION****2. Fuel Subsidy**

Total additional funding of \$926,050 will be provided to subsidise fuel costs from March to June, thereby ensuring the continued operational services of the Tuvalu Electricity Corporation (TEC) to the public.

**3. Vessel Fuel**

Total additional funding of \$765,621 will be provided to cover fuel operational costs for the *MV Nivaga III*, *MV Manu Folau*, *MV Manusina* and *LC Moeiteava*.
