TUVALU CIVIL AVIATION RULE PART 1 - DEFINITIONS AND ABBREVIATIONS

MADE UNDER SECTION 5(4) OF THE CIVIL AVIATION ACT

Description

Part 1 contains operative definitions and abbreviations used in the Civil Aviation Rules to facilitate the interpretation of those Rules.

Part 1 includes –

- (a) Definitions of specific terms used in the Rule Parts;
- (b) Abbreviations used in the Rule Parts.

1.1 General definitions

- (1) Where no definition is expressly covered in this Rule, the following applies:
 - (a) Terms that are defined in the Act shall take the meaning specified in the Act;
 - (b) Terms will otherwise take the meaning afforded to them in the New Zealand Civil Aviation Rules.
- (2) Unless the context otherwise requires, if there is any ambiguity between definitions contained in this Part and definitions specified in the Act, the Act shall prevail.

- (3) In Rules made under the Act, unless the context otherwise requires:

Act	means the Tuvalu Civil Aviation Act (2008)
Itinerant foreign aircraft operator	means the operator of a foreign registered aircraft that is not domiciled in Tuvalu.
Itinerant foreign aircraft	means a foreign registered aircraft that is visiting Tuvalu on an irregular or temporary basis, without scheduling and that is not based in Tuvalu.
Itinerant Visitor Permit	means the permit issued by the Director in accordance with the Rules, which allows a foreign registered aircraft operator to land in Tuvalu as an itinerant visitor.
Letter of Recognition	means the instrument of recognition issued by the Director to recognise a foreign-issued aviation document.
New Zealand Civil Aviation Rules	means the consolidated Rules made under the New Zealand Civil Aviation Act.

1.2 Abbreviation

- (1) Where no abbreviation is expressly covered in this Rule, the following applies:
- (a) Abbreviations that are defined in the Act shall take the meaning specified in the Act;
 - (b) Abbreviations will otherwise take the meaning afforded to them in the New Zealand Civil Aviation Rules;
- (2) Unless the context otherwise requires, if there is any ambiguity between definitions contained in this Part and definitions specified in the Act, the Act shall prevail.


