RELEASE DECISIONS

Detainee Name: Bill Kahi

Decision: The Board has approved his application for release on parole to remain on conditions until his sentence end date. We are satisfied he has taken further rehabilitation programs on the last three months and we are satisfied he poses no risk to the community.

Release Condition: - Undertake the Niufala Rod program from the Probation Services

- Avoid re-offending
- Undertake Rehab programs as well as Church programs
- Must return to Enima village, East Tanna and be under the supervision of Chief Varango Eligawa as community Justice Supervisor which will be appointed and set up by the Probation Services.
- Not to make contact with the victim whether indirect without approval of the Probation Officer.
- To continue to receive spiritual counselling with a Pastor to be identify by Probation Officer.
- He needs to shave off his beard before he is released on parole.

Release Date: Within 1 week from date of decision.

Certificate of Decision: Certify as true record of decision

Detainee Name: Ernest Jean William

Decision: The Board has approved his application for release on parole to remain until his sentence end date. He has good support of his Chief and Pastor. We are satisfied he has rehabilitated to the point he is no longer poses a risk to the community.

Release Condition: -To be supervised by Chief Pakoa Tariliumata as his Community Justice Supervisor (CJS).

- To undertake Spiritual Counselling/with Pastor Raymond Clay
- To undertake Niufala Rod Program as directed by a Probation Officer
- To undertake the Victim Awareness Module and the Sexual Offending Awareness Module as directed by the Probation Officer while on Parole
- To undertake the Wan Smol Bag Sexual Health Program as arranged by his supervising Probation Officer
- Not to re-offend or commit any other criminal offences.

Release Date: Within 1 week from date of decision

Certificate of Decision: Certify as true record of decision

Detainee Name: Michael Taninok

Decision: He is approved for release on parole to remain on conditions until his sentence end date. He has good support from the Chief of Pentecost and Fr.Mathias who is present at his hearing. We are happy to see a good business plan when all encourage him to persue for his benefit and for the community. We are satisfied he is adequately rehabilitated to return to the community.

Release Condition: -To reside at Nokonpok village, Pentecost Island under the supervision of Chief Godfrey Bule

- To undertake Spiritual Counselling with Pastor James Tovile
- To perform a custom ceremony to his victim and Chief and the community of painting a bad reputation to the community
- To undertake Niufala Rod Program as directed by a Probation Officer
- To undertake any rehabilitation program as directed by the Probation Officer
- Not to re-offend
- He needs to shave off his beard before he is released.

Release Date: Not until on or after 28th September 2019

Certificate of Decision: Certify as true record of decision

Detainee Name: Norman Tore

Decision: He is approved for release on parole to remain until his sentence end date. He has a good support for his Chief. He has sufficiently rehabilitated so his no risk to the community. He focuses on paying back the moneys he misappropriated.

Release Condition: -To reside only at Bladiniers Estate area and no other place else

- To be under the care and responsibility of Chief Ashlin Samsen
- To undertake Spiritual Counselling with Pastor Paul as directed by a Probation Officer
- To undertake Niufala Rod Program as directed by a Probation Officer
- Not to re-offend
- To comply with the restitution order issued by the court for repayment of moneys until they are fully paid.

Release Date: Within 1 week from date of decision

Certificate of Decision: Certify as true record of decision

Detainee Name: Shem Peter

Decision: His application is approved for release on parole to remain until his sentence end date. We are of the view he is mentally retarditated and we recommend that he be referred to the Vanuatu Disabled Center for any full assistance.

Release Condition: Not specified but the standard conditions are:

- Not to re-offend or commit other criminal offences
- To undertake Niufala Rod Program
- To be under supervision of his village chief
- To take spiritual counselling with a Pastor to be identify by his Probation Officer
- To undertake further rehabilitation programs as directed by Probation Officer

Release Date: Not until after 9th September 2019.
