ORDER TO PERFORM COMMUNITY WORK

50/84

TAFEA ISLAND COURT

To Local Government Council of TAFEA

Whereas Iarpat Saloki, Nasc Silas, Napuavan Jimmy, Yawia Jonah, Nalau Andre, Namu Nampai and Oscar Nase, all from Lounou, Whitesands were convicted before this court on 14th March, 1985 on this offence:-

Statement of offence: Headdtax Default, contrary to Section 9 of the TAFEA Regional Law.

Particulars of Offence: all the above said failed to pay their 1982/83 headdtax, plus a 50% surcharge.

And it was adjudged that the above said should pay a fine of VT2.500 out which a sum of VT1.500 should be paid to TAFEA Local Government Council as compensation and in default of payment of the fine the above said should be sentenced to a term of imprisonment not exceeding two months:

And whereas as an alternative to the said above undergoing such term of imprisonment the Court has determined in its discretion that they should perform specified work or work of a specified kind for communi purposes for a period of eight hours a day from Monday to Friday each week for three weeks commencing from.....198 and terminating on198

It is hereby ordered that you will supervise the said above in the performance of such community work as you may direct them to do subject to the following conditions:

That all above named will provide their own food and should any of t refuses to do community work will be imprisoned for three weeks.
