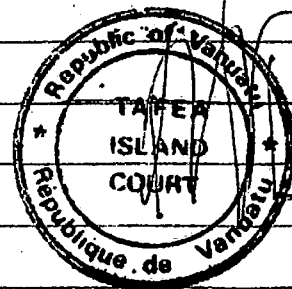
D/facts : The incident was true, but we followed the advised from MV Robin, MV LSP's son. He said that Kava belongs to him.

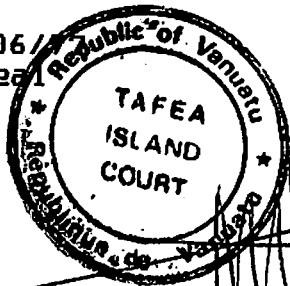
