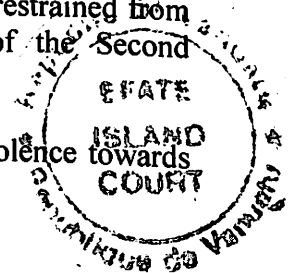

### ORDERS

1. That the First and Second Defendant be restrain from conducting any Development either clearing of Bushes, Building or any other developments within the Malasa Land until further orders of the Courts;

3. That all parties shall not threaten each other or show any acts violence towards each other until further orders of the Court;



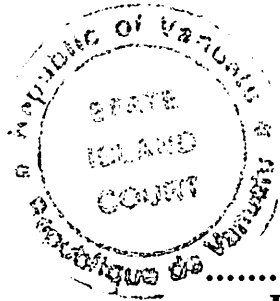
4. That any breach of the Court Orders the respective parties may be brought before the Court to be dealt with accordingly;
