ORDER

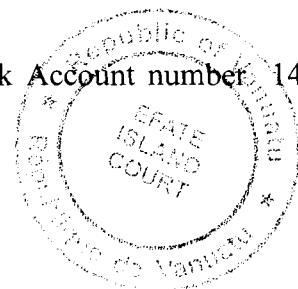
HAVING HEARD, the brief particulars of the claim presented by the Court Clerk and further, reading the statement of claim filed by Claimant 'GRACE LEE' on behalf of his unpaid sum;

Mr. Defendant 'MARIO TAMBE' did receive his notice of hearing on the 20th day of May 2014 but fail to appear before this court.

Rule 4 [2] (a) of the Island Court Procedure Rules of 2005 provide that, If a defendant does not appear at the time for the hearing of the claim, the court shall, provided it is satisfied that the statement of claim has been served on the defendant and that there is no good reason for the defendant's non-attendance: Determine in the absence of the defendant the claim of the claimant.

THEREFORE THE COURT HEREBY MAKES the following Orders:

1. Defendant MARIO TAMBER must pay the outstanding amount of VT 32'000 by 30th June 2014;
2. Payment must be made directly into the Claimant's Bank Account number: 14973301001 at BRED Bank – Port Vila Branch;




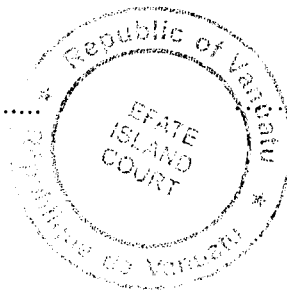
3. Section 19 of the Island Court Act No. 10 of 1993 makes it an offence where any person fails, without reasonable cause to obey an order of an Island Court. The penalty on conviction is a fine not exceeding VT 24.000 or Imprisonment not exceeding 6 month or both.
4. Party has liberty to appeal within 30 days as from today.
