JUDGEMENT

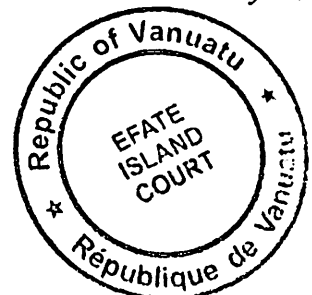
HAVING HEARD, the brief particulars of the claim presented by the Court Clerk and further, reading the statement of claim filed by Claimant 'DAISY NEMBU' on behalf of her unpaid sum of *Fifty thousand vatu*;

Rule 4 [2] (a) of the Island Court Procedure Rules of 2005 provide that, If a defendant does not appear at the time for the hearing of the claim, the court shall, provided it is satisfied that the statement of claim has been served on the defendant and that there is no good reason for the defendant's non-attendance: Determine in the absence of the defendant the claim of the claimant.

HAVING HEARD, the brief particulars of the claim presented by the court clerk and further, reading the statement of claim filed by Claimant on behalf of her unpaid sum;

NOW THEREFORE the Court hereby makes the following Orders:


1. Defendant JIMMY HOPMAN must pay the outstanding amount of VT 50'000 (*Fifty Thousand Vatu*) within two months : 25'000 vatu by 31st of July 2014 and another 25'000 vatu by 31st of August 2014 at 16:30pm ;
2. Payment must be made directly to the Claimant DAISY NEMBU;




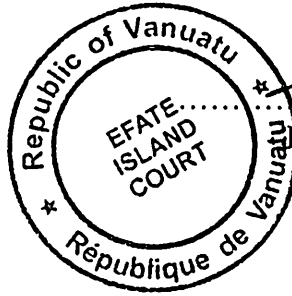
3. Section 19 of the Island Court Act No. 10 of 1993 makes it an offence where any person fails, without reasonable cause to obey an order of an Island Court. The penalty on conviction is a fine not exceeding VT 24.000 or Imprisonment not exceeding 6 month or both.
4. Party has liberty to appeal within 21 days as from today.
