JUDGMENT

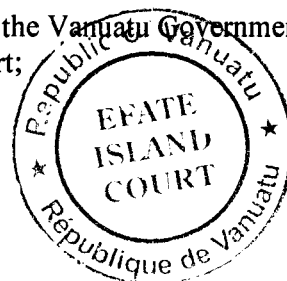
The defendants, Kiom Maki, is charged with the offence and pleaded guilty to the charge of **IDLE AND DISORDERLY**, against section 148(b), Penal Code Act Cap 135.

The facts provided by the prosecutor states that on the 30th of June 2016, close to Malasitapu Presbyterian Church, the defendant of this case namely Kiom Maki was totally under the influence of alcohol liquor and cannot control himself. Therefore, he acted in a disorderly manner where this place is a Public Place.

Having heard and considered the evidence provided by the Prosecutor and defense statement made by the defendant;

The Court is satisfied and hereby makes the following Orders:

1. The Court orders Kiom Maki, the Defendant to pay 2'000vt as Island Court Fine;
2. The Defendant Kiom Maki is also ordered to pay and 1'000vt as Prosecution;
3. All Payment must be made before the 15th day of March 2018 directly to the Vanuatu Government Cashier and copy of payment receipt to be shown at the Efate Island Court;



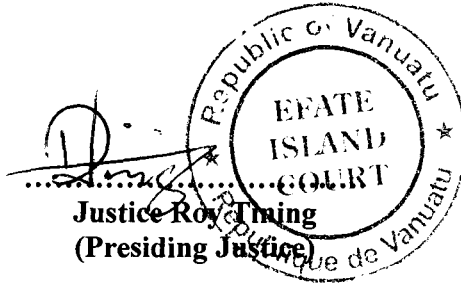
4. If either parties do not agree with the Judgement within 30 days upon receiving judgment have the right to appeal to the Magistrate Court.


