UPON Hearing Ms. Tari; the claimant, in the absence of the defendant Ms. Aaron, the Court is satisfied that:

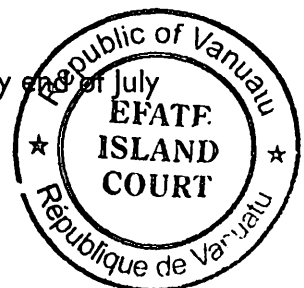
1. The defendant was served;
2. There is no response or defence filed by the defendant;
3. The defendant did not supply the Court with any valid reason for non-attendance;

THE COURT enters default judgement upon the application made by the claimant, and enters judgment in favour of the claimant as follows:

### **COURT ORDERS:**


- (1) The Defendant shall pay VT 52'000 in full by directly to the Efate Island Court by end of July 2022 to settle the matter;

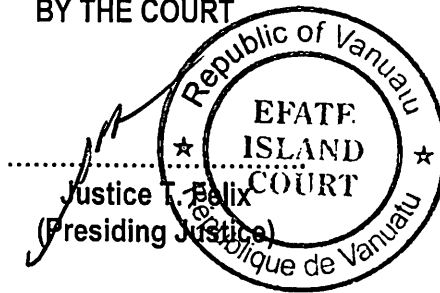



- (2) Party may apply orally or in writing to the Supervising Magistrate for Enforcement of the order or judgment if it remains unsatisfied;
