SENTENCE


HAVING Read and Heard Mr Beenman Sahe, for the State, and the Defendant Mrs. Marie-Laure Laloyer, the defendant pleads guilty to the charge of

- 1) **Fail to keep dangerous dog** - Contrary to Section 11 of the Control and Registration of the Dog Act Cap 64.


THE Court sentences the Defendant as follows:


1. That the Defendant, Marie-Laure Laloyer, must pay a fine of VT 5'000.
2. That the Defendant, must pay Prosecution costs of VT 2'000.
3. That the Defendant to pay the fine and the Prosecution costs before or by 15/08/2023 directly to Vanuatu Government Cashier and must provide copy of the payment receipt to the office of the Efate Island Court for records purposes.
4. That the Defendant has 30 days to appeal this sentence if she is not satisfied with it.
