SENTENCE

HAVING Read and Heard Mr. Titus Thompson for the State, and the Defendant Mr. Walter Kalmet, the defendant pleads guilty to the charges of:

- (1) **Damage to property** - Contrary to Section 133 of the Penal Code Act [Cap 135]
- (2) **Threatening** - Contrary to Section 114[A] of the Penal Code Act [Cap 135]

The Court considered the following mitigating factors:


- The defendant pleaded guilty to both charges at an early stage.
- The defendant has no previous criminal record.
- The defendant expressed remorse and cooperated with the police.


SENTENCE:


Having considered all the facts, including the seriousness of the offence and the defendant's personal circumstances, the Court imposes the following sentence:

- 1) The Defendant, Walter Kalmet, is to pay a fine of VT 18,000.
- 2) The Defendant is further ordered to pay Prosecution costs of VT 2,000.
- 3) The total amount (VT 20,000) must be paid on or before 14 November 2025 directly to the Vanuatu Government Cashier, located at the Ex-F.O.L Building, and a copy of the official payment receipt must be provided to the office of the Efate Island Court for records purposes.
- 4) The Defendant has 30 days from the date of this order to appeal the sentence if not satisfied.
