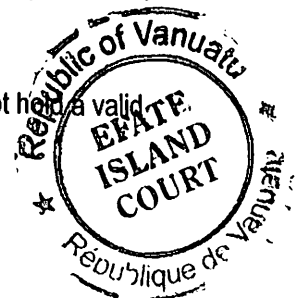
COURT MINUTE AND ORDERS

The Court heard Mr. Beeman Sahe, appearing on behalf of the State. He informed the Court that the Defendant had recently advised him, prior to the matter being called, that he had already paid fines to the Police Station in relation to this matter. In light of this information, Mr. Sahe made a verbal application requesting an adjournment to allow the Prosecution time to verify this information before the Court proceeds further.

The Defendant faces three charges, summarised below:

On 5 September 2024, at around 9:00 am on Shark Bay Public Road, Efate, the Defendant, Junino Kalo, is alleged to have committed the following offences under the Road Traffic Act [Cap 29]:

1. **Careless Driving:** Kalo allegedly drove a blue Toyota Hilux (registration 212449) carelessly, causing the vehicle to overturn.
2. **Driving Without a Learner's Licence:** At the time of the incident, Kalo did not hold a valid learner's driver's licence as required by law.




3. **Driving Without a Valid Driver's Licence:** Kalo also did not hold a valid full driver's licence, which he was legally required to possess.


The Court considered the application for adjournment and granted the request. The matter is adjourned to next year for plea, with the date to be confirmed by way of summons.
