This sixteenth day of Tay one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, in the matter of a charge against DONALD FRASER.

The above named DONALD FRASE: stands convicted by default of his appearance before the Joint Court for that on or about April 1911 ne did supply intoxicating liquor to a native named Montarero contrary to the provisions of article LIX of the Convention.

Thereupon the Joint Court sentences the said DONALD FRASER to pay a penalty of five pounds (£5) and costs.
