
Madame TARRES, French

The above named Madame TARRES stands convicted before the Joint
Court for that she did at Mele on the 6th October, supply 1
Bottle of cognac to natives TIKE and TOM contrary to Article
59 of the Anglo-French Convention of 1914.



Thereupon the Joint Court sentences the said Madame Tarres for
