Vila.


This twenty first day of January one thousand nine hundred and thirty.

In the matter of a charge against NABEME, Japanese, French Dependent, Storekeeper at Vila.

GF The above named NABEME stands ^{convicted} ~~guilty~~ of having at Siviri in the Island of Efate on the 12th December 1929 supplied for sale 2 cases (24 bottles) of cognac to native. Jimmy contrary to Article 59 of the Anglo-French Convention of 1914.

Thereupon the Joint Court sentences the said NABEME for his said offence to 20 days imprisonment and 1500 francs fine and the costs of the prosecution.
