- 1. This Regulation may be cited as the Registration of Business Names (Amendment) Regulation 1978 and upon its prior publication by the Resident Commissioner causing a copy ther thereof to be exhibited at the Public Office of the Resident Commissioner shall come into operation on the 1st day of January 1979.
- 2. Section 16(1) of the Registration of Business Mames Regulation is amended as follows -
 - (1) in paragraph (a), by deleting the word "one" and substituting therefor the word "ten";

(ii) in paragraph (c), by deleting the words "fifty cents" and substituting therefor the words "five dollars".
