A JOINT REGULATION

Issued by the Resident Commissioners in accordance with the ovisions of Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

- 1. Whenever it shall appear desirable to the Resident Commisioners that the boundary of any block of land or of any portion hereof should be more clearly defined or ascertained, the Resident commissioners acting jointly, may serve or cause to be served by my person authorised by them notice on the owner or occupier of my such land requiring him within the period specified in such lotice, to clear, define, or otherwise ascertain the boundary of the aid land to the satisfaction of an official surveyor (or other qualified erson) specified in the said notice.
- 2. Any person who fails to comply with the terms of any office or who prevents or obstructs the execution of any of the terms of the said notice, issued under the provisions of this Regulation hall be guilty of an offence against this Regulation.
- 3. In the event of failure to comply with the terms of any notice erved under this Regulation the Resident Commissioners may take or order to be taken such steps as may be required to ensure the accution of any work required by such notice, the cost of which shall be recoverable from the person concerned. Any person who prevents or obstructs the execution of any work as aforesaid shall be guilty of an offence against this Regulation.
- 4. Offences against this Regulation shall be punishable by a ne not exceeding £20 and imprisonment not exceeding one month or by one or other of such penalties.
- 5. This Regulation shall come into force on the day of the ate hereof and may be cited for all purposes as "The New Hebrides Definition of Land Boundaries Regulation No. 2 of 1941".
