tiereas by Article 21, paragraph (b) 4 of the Anglo-French otocol of 1914, it is provided that Courts of First Instance shall be hablished in the Administrative Districts provided for in Article 2, tragraph 3, of the said Protocol;

And whereas by Proclamation dated 7th January, 1925, Adminirative Districts hereinbefore referred to were established.

1. The Resident Commissioners of His Britannic Majesty and the French Republic hereby order that a Court of First Instance fall be instituted within the limits of Central District No. 2 with fadquarters at a place known as Bushman's Bay on the island of falekula, and such Court shall make circuits of the district as and then necessary. The territorial jurisdiction of such Court shall imprise the whole of Central District No. 2 as defined by Proclamaton dated 7th January, 1925.

Institution of Court. Headquarters. Territorial jurisdiction.

2. This Regulation shall come into force seven days after the frival in Vila of the Condominium Gazette in which the present egulation shall have been published.

Date of coming into force.

This Regulation shall be known as the "New Hebrides Instituon of Court of First Instance Regulation No. 5 of 1928".
