MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of ticle 2.2 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

- 1. There is hereby created at Luganville a Town Planning mmission composed of the following—
 - (i) There is hereby created at Luganville a Town Planning Commission which shall be a permanent sub-committee of the Advisory Town Council. It shall be composed of the following members:

The Co-Presidents of the Advisory Town Council Joint Chairmen;

The Condominium Medical Officer at Luganville or his deputy;

The District Engineer at Luganville or his deputy;

and four unofficial members of the Advisory Town Council, to be nominated annually by a motion of the Council.

Five members shall constitute a quorum.

- (ii) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Joint Regulation No. 16 of 1966, the Co-Presidents of the Advisory Town Council shall have the right to vote in the deliberations of the Town Planning Commission.
- The Town Planning Commission shall exercise within the limits of Luganville the powers conferred on the Town Planning mission at Vila, created by Joint Regulation No. 6 of 1954, and, ticular, shall apply the provisions of Joint Regulation No. 6 of as amended.
