## A JOINT REGULATION

No. 2 of 1952.

To prevent damage to electric and telephone cables connecting Iririki and the mainland.

[Joint Regulation No. 2 of 1952 was published in Condominium Gazette No. 177 and is reprinted as amended by Joint Regulation No. 1 of 1954 (Condominium Gazette No. 182).]

Made by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Article 7 of the Anglo-French protocol of 1914.

1. No vessel shall anchor within the waters enclosed by a line drawn from the Residency Jetty, Iririki, to the Southern extremity of "D" Dock and a line drawn from the Southern extremity of Burns Philip (N.H.) Ltd. wharf to the Northernmost point of Iririki island. This prohibited zone will be clearly marked by signs.]

Prohibited area for ships.

J.R, 1 of 1954.

2. Infractions of the provisions of this Regulation shall be punishable by a penalty not exceeding a fine of £20.

Penalties.

3. This Regulation, which may be cited as the New Hebrides Vila Harbour Joint Regulation No. 2 of 1952, shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.
