NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

N° 2 of 1974

TO AMEND the New Hebrides (Explosives) Regulation N° 1 of 1917 (N° 2 of 1917 in the French text).

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Article 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Replacement s.6 of J.R. N° 1 of 1917

- 1. Section 6 of the New Hebrides (Explosives)
 Regulation N° 1 of 1917 (N° 2 of 1917 in the French text)
 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section -
- "Offences 6. Any person contravening the provisions of this Regulation shall be liable on conviction, in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding 50,000 FNH or the equivalent thereof in Australian dollars at the official rate of exchange or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both such fine and imprisonment and in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to double such penalties. "

Citation and commencement

2. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Explosives (Amendment) Regulation N° 2 of 1974 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
