## JOINT REGULATION

No.11 of 1976

TO AMEND Joint Regulation No. 22 of 1944.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2, 7 and 3 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

New s.1A added to J.R. No. 22 of 1944

1. Joint Regulation No. 22 of 1944 is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 1 the following new section -

"Seizure of goods etc.

- 1A. (1) Any police or customs officer may, if he has grounds for suspecting that any article, goods, vehicle, vessel or aircraft is being used or is intended for use in the promotion or furtherance of any movement to which section 1 applies seize the same, regardless of the ownership thereof or in whose possession it may be found.
- (2) Such officer shall thereupon prepare a written report for consideration by the Resident Commissioners who may, if they are satisfied that the article, goods, vehicle, vessel or aircraft seized by the officer was at the time of seizure being used or intended to be used for the promotion or furtherance of any movement to which section 1 applies, by joint decision declare the same to be forfeit and prescribe in such decision the measures to be taken for the disposal or destruction thereof. ".

Commencement

2. This Regulation shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
