STATE OF EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 4 OF 1998

To provide for the restoration and maintenance of public order:

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in Article 69 of the Constitution **WE, THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS** hereby make the following Order:

STATE OF EMERGENCY

For the purpose of restoring public order a State of Emergency has been declared by Order dated 13th January, 1998 pursuant to Article 69 of the Constitution, and these regulations are made accordingly.

POLICE TO CARRY ARMS

- For the period of the State of Emergency (as fixed under Article 70 of the (1) Constitution) the Commissioner of Police, in accordance with a direction from the Prime Minister may authorise members of the Vanuatu Police Force (not being special constables appointed under State of Emergency Order No. 2 of 1998) to carry and use firearms in accordance with the rules of engagement contained in the Schedule hereto.
 - (2) For the avoidance of doubt members of the Vanuatu Police Force includes members of the Vanuatu Mobile Force.

COMMENCEMENT

This Order shall come into force on the 4 day of January 1998.
