LIQUOR LICENSING (PROHIBITION) ORDER
NO. 3 OF 1987

An Order to prohibit the sale and supply of liquor in Luganville.

IN EXERCISE of the power conferred by section 14A of the Joint Liquor Licensing Regulation No.18 of 1968 as amended, I hereby make the following Order:-

SALE OF LIQUOR IN LUGANVILLE PROHIBITED

1. Subject to Clause 2, the sale and supply of alcoholic liquor at licenced premises within the Luganville Municipality, whether for consumption on or off the premises, is hereby prohibited from midnight on Saturday the 17th day of January 1987 until midnight on Tuesday the 20th day of January, 1987.

EXCEPTION

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Clause 1, alcoholic liquor may be sold during the said period within the normal hours of opening in restaurants and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with their meals.

COMMENCEMENT

3. This Order shall come into force on the 17th day of January, 1987.
