

# REPUBLIC OF VANUATU

## TRADE DISPUTES ACT [CAP 162]

### Discontinuance of Industrial Action

### Order No. 4 of 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsections 34 (1), (2), and (3) of the Trade Disputes Act [CAP 162], I Honourable GEORGE WELLS, Minister for Internal Affairs make the following Order.

#### **1 Discontinuance of industrial action**

During the period for which this order remains in force, no member of a class of person specified under Clause 2 of this Order shall call, organize, procure or finance a strike, or any irregular industrial action, or threaten to do so, or institute, carry on, organize, procure or finance a lock-out or threaten to do so.

#### **2 Application of Order**


This Order applies to the following persons or members of a class of persons:

- (a) the Vanuatu National Workers Union and all its registered members and any member of the general public who has an interest in the issues surrounding the Vanuatu Workers Union in relation to the Unelco Vanuatu Limited following the ongoing conciliation process;
- (b) Mr. Ephraim Kalsakau, General Secretary of the Vanuatu National Worker's Union,
- (c) Mr. Gislain Kaltack, President, Union Representative;
- (d) Mme. Marie Alexis Liatlatmal, Union Representative;
- (e) Mme. Sabrina Korikalo, Union Representative;
- (f) Mr. Gremson Valua, Union Representative;
- (g) all staff of the Unelco Vanuatu Limited and their relatives;
- (h) members of the general public.

**3 Commencement**

This Order commences on the 16th February 2006 and ceases to have effect on the 16th April 2006.
