NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that petitions for the winding up of the abovenamed companies by the Supreme Court of Vanuatu holden at Vila, were on the seventh day of July, 1982, presented to the said Court by STANLEY UREN, Registrar of Companies, Vila, AND that the said petitions are directed to be heard before the Court sitting at Vila on the twenty-first day of July, 1982, and any creditor or contributory of the said companies desirous to support or oppose the making of an order on the said petitions may appear at the time of hearing in person or by his counsel for that purpose; and a copy of the petition(s) will be furnished by the undersigned to any creditor or contributory of the said companies requiring such copy on payment of the regulated charge for the same.

REGISTRAR OF COMPANIES

NOTE: Any person who intends to appear on the hearing of the said petition(s) must serve on or send by post to the abovenamed, notice in writing of his intention so to do. The notice must state the name and address of the person, or, if a firm, the name and address of the firm and must be signed by the person or firm or his or their solicitor (if any), and must be served, or if posted, must be sent by post, in sufficient time to reach the abovenamed not later than one o'clock in the afternoon on the nineteenth day of July, 1982.
