THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (DECLARATION
OF CANDIDATURE) ORDER No. 37 OF 1989

To declare the closing date for the lodging of declaration of candidature for the BY-ELECTION for seven vacant seats of Parliament, to be held on November 28th 1989 further to:-

- The resignation of five members of Parliament ;
- The election of the new President of the Republic of Vanuatu ;
- The application of section 25 (2) of the Representation of People Act No. 13 of 1982.

IN EXERCISE of the power contained in section 65 and 21 (1) of the Representation of the People Act No. 13 of 1982 as amended, THE ELECTORAL COMMISSION HEREBY MAKES the following order :

CLOSING DATE OF DECLARATION OF CANDIDATURE

1. The Electoral Commission declares that persons who wish to stand as candidates for the By-Election to Parliament to be held on November 28th, 1989 and who are qualified and eligible according to sections 19 and 20 of the Representation of the People Act No. 13 of 1982 as amended, shall as of this date until not later than the 3rd day of November, 1989 at the hour of 16.30, lodge their candidature for the By-Election to Parliament in accordance with the requirements of section 21 of the said Act, with the Electoral Office or Secretary of Local Government Councils or Town Clerks of:

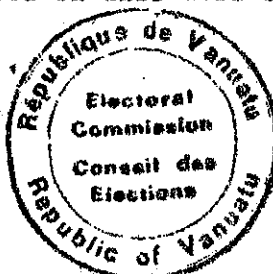

AIRPORT (INTERNATIONAL) (METHOD OF COLLECTION)
DEPARTURE TAX ORDER No. 28 OF 1989

To provide for a method of collection of departure tax in respect of international airtravellers departing from Bauerfield, Pekoa Airport or Burton-Lenakel.

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 3(3) of the Joint Airport Departure Tax Regulation No. 57 of 1973 as amended from time to time, I hereby make the following Order -

EXECUTING AUTHORITY

1. (a) The Executing Authority of this Order shall in the first instance be the person for the time being appointed as the Director of Civil Aviation.
- (b) Executing Authority shall procure all acts, obligations or responsibilities necessary to be performed to ensure the effective functioning of this Order.

ISSUING OF STAMPS

2. Stamps shall be issued to such hotels, banks, post offices, or retail stores and such other outlets or venues as may be appropriate for sale to intending travellers.


COLLECTION OF PROCEEDS

3. (a) All proceeds from the sale of stamps shall be collected from the vendors at the end of each month.
- (b) Any proceeds unpaid shall be deemed a debt by the vendor and may be recovered by civil proceedings.

COMMENCEMENT

4. This Order shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Gazette.

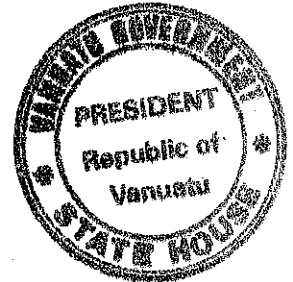
