INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE SOUTH PACIFIC FORUM SECRETARIAT

WHEREAS:

- A. The Agreement establishing the South Pacific Forum Secretariat (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") was signed in Pohnapei, on 29 July, 1991;
- B. Article XII(4) provides that -
- (i) the Agreement shall be subject to ratification;
 - (ii) such ratification shall be effected by the deposit of an instrument to that effect with the Government of the Republic of Fiji;
- C. By virtue of the Agreement Establishing the South Pacific Forum Secretariat (Ratification) Act No. 25 of 1992, the Parliament of the Republic of Vanuatu ratified the Agreement;
- D. The Council of Ministers of the Republic of Vanuatu has empowered and authorized the Acting Prime Minister and Minister responsible for Foreign Affairs to sign this instrument of Ratification on behalf of the Republic of Vanuatu;

NOW THEREFORE The Republic of Vanuatu HEREBY NOTIFIES the Government of the Republic of Fiji of its ratification of the Agreement.

- A. The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (hereinafter referred to as the "Convention") was signed in Rio, on 10 June, 1992;
- B. Article 22(1) provides that -
- (i) the Convention shall be subject to ratification, acceptance, approval or accession by states;
 - (ii) such ratification, acceptance, approval or accession shall be effected by the deposit of an instrument to that effect with the Secretary General of the United Nations;
- C. By virtue of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (Ratification) Act No. 24 of 1992, the Parliament of the Republic of Vanuatu ratified the Convention;
- D. The Council of Ministers of the Republic of Vanuatu has empowered and authorized the Acting Prime Minister and Minister responsible for Foreign Affairs to sign this Instrument of Ratification on behalf of the Republic of Vanuatu.

NOW THEREFORE - The Republic of Vanuatu HEREBY NOTIFIES the Secretary General of the United Nations of its ratification of the Convention.

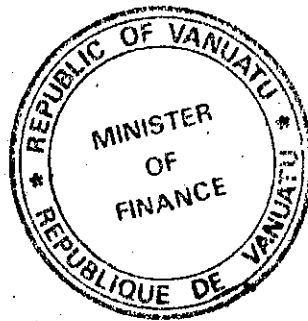

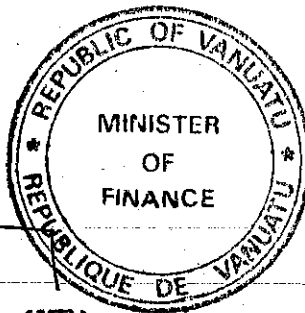
