CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC

REDUCTION OF SENTENCE

WHEREAS Article 38 of the Constitution provides, inter alia, for the President of the Republic to reduce a sentence imposed on a person convicted of an offence;

AND WHEREAS the persons specified by name in this Instrument have been sentenced to various terms of imprisonment;

AND WHEREAS the Committee constituted under article 38 of the Constitution has advised the President on the reduction of sentence imposed on various prisoners specified in this Instrument;

NOW THEREFORE in the exercise of the power conferred on me by Article 38 of the Constitution, **I, JEAN-MARIE LEYE LENELCAU MANATAWAI**, President of the Republic of Vanuatu, hereby reduce the sentence imposed on the prisoners whose names appear in the first column in the following table by the term specified in the third column corresponding to the prisoners name in the first column -
