CHAPTER 159

**THE CIVIL AVIATION (REGULATIONS)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER NO. 17 OF 1998**

To amend the Civil Aviation (regulations) Order No. 31 of 1987.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3(1) of the Civil Aviation Act [CAP. 159], **I. DEMIS LANGO**, Minister of Civil Aviation, Telecommunications, Postal Services and Meteorology, hereby make the following regulations:-

AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 2 OF ORDER NO. 31 OF 1987.

1. The Civil Aviation (regulations) Order No. 31 of 1987 in this order referred to as the "principal order" is amended in subregulation 2(1):
 - (a) by deleting the time period of "2 hours" and inserting "12 hours" in place thereof.

AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 3.

2. Regulation 3 of the principal order is amended in subregulations (a) and (b):-
 - (a) by deleting figure "7" which relates to standard landing fee per hour of parking for every winged aircraft, and inserting figure "14" in place thereof.
 - (b) by deleting figure "7" which relates to half the standard landing fee per hour in the case of helicopter, and inserting figure "14" in place thereof.

AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 4


3. Regulation 4 of the principle order is amended:

- (a) by deleting figure "7" which relates to standard landing fees plus standard night landing fee for every aircraft parked overnight and inserting figure "14" in place thereof.

COMMENCEMENT

4. This order shall come into force on the day of its publication in the Gazette.
