RESERVE BANK OF VANUATU ACT 1980, CAP 125

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 33


PRESCRIBED RESERVES (PR) AND STATUTORY RESERVE DEPOSIT

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu under Section 33 of the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu Act 1980, Cap 125, notice is hereby given that with effect from the first working day in November 1998 each licensed financial institution in Vanuatu will be required to maintain minimum holdings of Prescribed Reserves equivalent to but not less than 10 percent of average vatu deposits of residents held by the financial institution for the previous two months. The Prescribed Reserve assets are specified in the attached Schedule.

Effective on the same day the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu, under Section 33 of the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu Act 1980, Cap 125, is re-introducing the Statutory Reserve Deposit Ratio to manage liquidity. Notice is hereby given that with effect from the first working day in November 1998 each licensed financial institution in Vanuatu will be required to maintain on minimum holdings of Statutory Reserve Deposit equivalent to but not less than 6 percent of average vatu deposits of residents held by the financial institution for the previous two months.

This Gazette notice supersedes the relevant Gazetted notice of 27 February 1998.
