2. Any eligible person may submit their declaration of candidature for the above bye-election as from The 10th day of June 1999 until not later than 4.30 p.m. on the 21st day of June 1999 to Principal Electoral Officer in Port Vila or to the Secretary of the PENAMA Provincial Government Council.



1. The Bye-Election for the Constituencies of Malo/Aore, Pentecost, and Tongoa shall be held on the 31st of August, 1999.


