LIQUOR LICENCING ACT [CAP. 52]

Liquor Licensing (Prohibition of Sale) Order No. 48 of 2005

To provide for a prohibition on the sale of liquor in Port Vila.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 19 of the Liquor Licensing Act [CAP. 52], I, GEORGE WELLS, Minister of Internal Affairs, make the following Order:

1 Sale of Liquor prohibited

The sale of liquor in or from licensed premises throughout Port Vila whether for consumption on or off such premises is prohibited from 12 noon on Thursday 13th day of October 2005 to 6 pm Sunday 17th day of October 2005.

2 Exception


Liquor may be sold during the period referred to in section 1 within the normal hours of opening in restaurants and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with food.

3 Commencement

This Order comes into force on the day on which it is made.

BYE-LAW NO.2 2005

LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL (ENFORCEMENT OFFICER)
BYE-LAW NO. 2 OF 2005

A Bye-Law to make provisions for the duties and functions of an Enforcement Officer. IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred to section 20 of the Decentralization Act No.1 of 1994, the Local Government Council, hereby makes the following Bye-Laws;

INTEPRETATION

1. In this bye-law unless the context otherwise requires-

“Act” means the Decentralization Act No. 1 of 1994

“Council” means Local Government Council established under section 4 of the Local Government Regions (Consolidation Order No.1 of 1996;

“Enforcement Officers” means and Officer or an employee or an agent appointed by the Council under section 2;

“Region” means the Local Government Region established under section 4 of the Local Government Regions (Consolidation) Order No.1 of 1996;

ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

2. (a) The Council may from time to time appoint fit persons, not being councilors, to be enforcement officers for Region on such terms and conditions as the Council may determine.
- (b) The Enforcement Officers shall be insured in the cause of their duties.

DUTIES AND FUNCTION OF ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

3. (1) The Enforcement Officer shall, under the director of the Council:-
 - (a) be responsible for the enforcement of bye-laws with Province and its
 - (b) exercise such powers and perform such duties and functions as are by law conferred or imposed on the enforcement officers.
- (2) Without derogating from Subsection (1), the Enforcement Officer may perform the following duties and functions:-
 - (a) ascertain whether persons carrying on business within Region having paid their business licenses fees, taxes, dues or charges required under any bye-law;
 - (b) ensure that sales and export of marine products with Region comply with bye-laws or national laws;
 - © to report any violation of bye-laws which amount to a criminal offence to the Public Prosecutor;
 - (d) demand the presentation of license and inspect license;
 - (e) enter premises where he/she has reasonable grounds to believe that the law has been breached;

- (f) ensure that developments of kinds are implemented in line with the Council's Physical Planning Act;

CIVIL DEBT PROCEEDINGS

4. Any fee, tax due or charge not paid shall be recovered as civil debts. Provided that the Enforcement Officer must have exhausted all avenues of recovering the debts.

COMMENCEMENT

2. This Bye-Law shall come into force on the day of its publication in the Gazette.

MUNICIPALITIES ACT [CAP. 126]

Instrument of appointment of a person to exercise powers of the Port Vila Municipal Council

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsection 61(3) of the Municipalities Act [CAP. 126], I, the Honourable GEORGE WELLS, Minister of Internal Affairs, make the following appointment:

1 Appointment

Mr Hannington Alatoa ("Mr Alatoa") is appointed to exercise the powers of the Port Vila Municipal Council so suspended under section 61 of the Municipalities Act [CAP 126].

2 Period of appointment

The period of appointment commences on the date on which the Minister suspends the current Port Vila Municipal Council and ends on the date on which the results of the Port Vila Municipal Council election that is due to be held on 31st day of October 2005 is published in the Gazette.

3 Allowance

Mr Alatoa is entitled to an allowance of VT 120,000 per month.

4 Payment of allowance

The allowance referred to in clause 3 is payable from the date on which this order is made.

5 Use of Council vehicles

Mr Alatoa is to have access to the cars of the Municipal Council of Port Vila for purposes associated with carrying out the powers of the Council.


6 Other benefits, allowances and entitlements

No other benefits, allowances or entitlements are to be paid to Mr Alatoa during his term of office other than those referred to under clauses 3 and 5 of this instrument.


