**IN EXERCISE** of the powers contained in section 70 of the Public Finance and Economic Management Act No.6 of 1998, I **CARCASSES MOANA KALOSIL** Minister of Finance and Economic Management, make the following order:

## **PART 2**

## **FINANCIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Regulations are amended to add the following Regulation after Regulation 2.3.

### **Regulation 2.4.**

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE INTERNAL AUDIT UNIT**

- (1) The Director General of MFEM shall establish an Internal Audit Unit within the Ministry of Finance and Economic Management to carry out a continuous and independent appraisal of the accounting, financial and other manual and electronic systems, controls and procedures of the government so as to assist the Director-General and other agency heads in meeting their responsibilities under the Public Finance and Economic Management Act. Its focus will be on maintaining and improving the effectiveness of financial and other operations and protecting the government and its assets against fraud, loss and inefficiency.
- (2) The Internal Audit Unit within the Ministry of Finance and Economic Management will be headed by a Principal Auditor and will be supplemented by Internal Auditors in other ministries, taking into account the minimum number that the Minister may decide is necessary to provide an effective Internal Audit service within the relevant ministry.
- (3) The Internal Audit Unit shall help management to ensure that acceptable standards of accounting and administration are maintained and that its operations are carried out with proper regard for efficiency and economy.
- (4) The work of the Internal Audit Unit will be overseen by an Internal Audit Committee. The members of the Internal Audit Committee will be appointed by the Director-General and shall include the Auditor-General or a person nominated by the Auditor-General, the heads of other agencies with an Internal Auditor and the Director of Finance.
- (5) The Internal Audit Committee shall meet at least every 3 months. The Chairman of the Internal Audit Committee shall convene meetings more frequently than this when there is an urgent need to do so.
- (6) Before the start of each financial year, the Principal Auditor, in cooperation with Internal Auditors in other ministries and the Director of Finance, will prepare an audit plan for consideration by the Audit Committee. The Director-General will authorise the annual audit plan for the Audit Unit in accordance with advice from the Audit Committee.
- (7) Copies of the Audit Unit's audit reports shall be submitted to the Director-General of MFEM, to the head of the relevant ministry, to the Director of Finance and to the Audit Committee. The Principal Auditor shall be responsible for coordinating the presentation of audit reports to the Audit Committee. In exceptional circumstances, the Audit Unit may also provide

copies to the Minister. The Audit Committee shall, at its next meeting, provide advice to the Director-General on action to be taken on the findings of the Audit reports.

- (8) The Director-General shall decide on action to be taken in relation to Audit reports within a period of 2 months of receiving advice from the Audit Committee on a report, and shall provide advice in writing to the Committee where he decides on action other than that recommended by it.
- (9) At the end of each financial year, the Manager of the Internal Audit Unit will report to the Audit Committee and the Director-General on whether the audits scheduled in the annual audit plan have been completed and, if not, the reasons for non-compliance with the annual audit plan.
- (10) The staff of the Audit Unit shall have access to all records, assets, personnel and premises and shall obtain such information and explanations, as they consider necessary to fulfil their responsibilities. All public sector employees, including government personnel and agency employees, as well as advisers, are required to answer fully and truthfully any reasonable questions asked of them by the Audit Unit.
- (11) Where an Internal Auditor suspects fraud or corruption they must immediately notify the Principal Auditor and the Director General of MFEM and the Director of Finance and any supporting documentation must be secured. The Internal Audit Unit should recommend whatever investigation is considered necessary in the circumstances. Thereafter the internal audit unit should follow-up to see that management's responsibilities have been met. However where there is a possibility that the Director General of MFEM or the Director of Finance may be involved, the Principal Auditor must inform the Minister of Finance directly. The Director-General of Finance or the Minister, as the case may be, must make a decision within 2 months of receiving a report on any suspected corruption and must provide reasons, in writing, where he elects not to follow the recommendation of the Audit report.
