


Declaration of Public Holiday Order No 120 of 2010



In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 35(1), I, Acting Director of Civil Aviation Authority, make the following amendment to Order 118 of 2010.


1 Amendments

2 Clause 2

"2 Time of use of crackers and rockets

- (1) The time allowed for the use of crackers and rockets in Vanuatu is between 18:00 hours to 1:00 hours.
- (2) The use of crackers and rockets must not be carried out beyond the time specified in subclause (1)."


