
**UPON READING** the Application and verifying the Sworn Statement of **REBECCA ANNE EDWARDS** dated 24<sup>th</sup> February 2011 **AND UPON HEARING THE APPLICATION** dated 24<sup>th</sup> February 2011 filed on behalf of the said **REBECCA ANNE EDWARDS**, THIS COURT, being satisfied that the said **REBECCA ANNE EDWARDS** is duly qualified for admission as a Barrister and Solicitor of this Court and as a Legal Practitioner and that he has taken the requisite oaths on admission, **ORDERS** that:-

1. THAT, REBECCA ANNE EDWARDS , of C/- Ronald Kay Warsal & Co, Port-Vila, be temporarily admitted as a Barrister and Solicitor in Vanuatu, pursuant to the provisions of Section 18 of the Legal Practitioners Act 2006;
2. THAT, such admission be subject to the restrictions imposed by sections 18, 19, 20 and 21 of the Legal Practitioners Act 2006;

## Legal Practitioners Regulation Act (as amended) CAP 119 (Section 13)

### TEMPORARY PRACTICING CERTIFICATE

#### Certificate No. 03 of 2011

- A. This is to certify that **REBECCA ANNE EDWARDS** of Bankside Chambers, Level 22 Lumley Centre, 88 Shortland St, PO Box 1136 **Shortland St, Auckland** has been granted a temporary practicing certificate for the purpose of appearing in the Supreme Court on the following cause or matter:

***Thi Tham Goiset and Jean Marcel Goiset -v-Westpac Banking Corporation - Civil Case No. 77 of 2010.***

The Claim involves Breach of Contract, Unconscionability/Estoppel, Negligence, Misrepresentation, Breach of Mortgage duties as well as Banking Law and breaches of fiduciary duties by a Bank.

- B. This Certificate is granted subject to certain conditions as set by the Law Council, including the following:
- (a) The holder of this Certificate shall only act on the instructions of **Ronald Kay Warsal** of RONALD KAY WARSAL & Co LAWYERS who is a registered legal practitioner entitled to practice in Vanuatu.
  - (b) The holder of this Certificate shall not engage in any legal work of any description other than the legal work necessarily connected with the case, matter or cause set out above.
  - (c) The holder of this Certificate while in Vanuatu for the above-named case, cause or matter shall not hold himself out as a lawyer entitled to practice in Vanuatu, nor shall he accept any other brief from the said or from any other person.
  - (d) The holder of this Certificate shall, during the subsistence of this Certificate, ensure that he has complied with all the relevant laws of Vanuatu relating to residence and employment of noncitizens.
  - (e) This Certificate shall cease to have effect upon final determination by the Supreme Court or the Court of Appeal, as the case may be, of the case, matter or cause mentioned above.
  - (f) This Certificate does not permit the holder to appear in any other

Courts or tribunals in Vanuatu other than the Supreme Court or the Court of Appeal.
